CONDITIONS

1. The competition will be 18 holes, singles, qualifying, stroke play.
2. The competition is open to junior members of recognised golf clubs, who are aged 17 or under on 1st January of the year played. Playing handicaps under the current Unified Handicapping System of C.O.N.G.U. may not exceed 28 for Boys, 36 for Girls.
3. Completed application forms **must** be accompanied by the entry fee and stamped addressed envelope.
4. The competition committee reserves the right to refuse entry without having to give a reason.
5. The Start Sheet will be published on the Lingdale Golf Club website on the Friday before the competition.
6. Applicants not notified by **11-August-2011** should enquire of secretary@lingdalegolfclub.co.uk or phone 01509 890703.
7. The competition committee reserves the right to fix/alter starting times.
8. Competitors must conform to the Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the local rules of Lingdale Golf Club.
9. Caddies will not be allowed.
10. The prize table will be determined by the level and composition of the field.
11. Boys to play from white tees Girls to play from red tees.
12. Girls will receive 1 additional course adjustment stroke, for competition scoring purposes only.
13. All ties will be decided by the last 9, 6, 3, 2, or 1 holes of the card.
15. No competitor may receive more than one prize, they will receive the prize of higher value and remaining prizes will be awarded for the next best scores as appropriate. Players with inactive handicaps are not eligible for prizes.
16. All prize winners are expected to attend the prize giving. Prizes not presented on the day must be collected.
17. All disputes shall be decided by the competition committee whose decision will be final.
18. Lingdale Golf Club cannot accept any responsibility for thefts and accidents and competitors must carry their own insurance.
19. Competitors must protect themselves in Health and Safety matters, especially should there be a danger from lightning, when play must stop immediately and not be resumed until the danger has passed.
20. If there is a long blast of a klaxon, play must stop immediately and not be resumed until two short blasts of the klaxon are heard.
21. Competitors must comply with any further conditions advised on the day of competition.
